SAFETY AND DROP OFF AT PICK UP

When you drop off or pick up your children please follow the road rules and take note of the parking signs. Across from the school is a 5 minute drop off parking zone during the hours of 8:00 - 9:30am and 2:30 - 4:00pm. The 5 minutes allows enough time to park and escort your child safely across the road. Children up to 10 should be supervised around traffic and should hold an adult's hand when crossing the road. Children going to Kiss and Drop are supervised by teachers walking from the school. If you are collecting your child from the front of the hall please come inside the gates so that the children going to Kiss and Drop have a clear, safe walking passage.
