PARENT INFORMATION SESSION – LITERACY

When: Friday November 16 - after assembly

Where: Maria Regina School Hall

Presenter: Jane Denny Education Officer CSO - Curriculum, Teaching and Learning K-12 This parent session will highlight the current practices in teaching literacy with a particular focus on spelling. Parents will have the opportunity to understand recent changes in the teaching and learning of spelling and how spelling is connected to both reading and writing. Information and suggestions will be provided to support this learning at home.

SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL LEARNING

The feelings thermometer is a wonderful tool for teaching self-management and emotional awareness to students. This tool has been explicitly taught to all students so that children feel comfortable identifying how they are feeling. When the children reach a red level (angry/furious), we utilize calming breathing techniques in order to relax them. Children are encouraged to use the chill out zone in the classroom to redirect their focus so that they can begin to calm down. In the chill out zones there are soft toys, story books, cushions, inspirational quotes, the feelings thermometer and the consequence matrix which all help to settle students so that they can return to the blue level.





POSITIVE BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING

In Week 3 the PBL Focus has been to speak and act with kindness. In week 4 the focus will be let others learn. Students have a responsibility for their own learning and to allow the learning of others through their actions. Letting others learn looks like not talking to friends during instructions and work time, speaking appropriately during discussions and group work, demonstrating self-control (not fidgeting, ignoring others who are being distracting, being responsible when choosing where to sit), giving positive feedback to peers and always trying your best.

Changes to the management of overdue school fees.

The management of <u>overdue</u> school fees within the Diocese of Broken Bay will be centralised at the Catholic Schools Office located at Pennant Hills. The new arrangement will be a staged implementation across all schools, and will impact Maria Regina Avalon from 26th November, 2018.

This will ensure a consistent approach to managing <u>overdue</u> school fees across Broken Bay systemic schools, and reduce operating costs following recent funding changes.
